Reminder!

The gerund in Spanish is formed:

- Regular verbs:

- o For 'AR' verbs: we drop the 'ar' ending and we add 'ando' to the root of the verb. For example:

HABLAR HABLANDO

ESTUDIAR ESTUDIANDO

- o For 'ER' and 'IR' verbs: we drop the 'er' or the 'ir' ending and we are 'iendo' to the root of the verb. For example:

COMER COMIENDO

BEBERBEBIENDO

VIVIR VIVIENDO
ESCRIBIR ESCRIBIENDO

- Irregular verbs:

Ir yendo
Morir muriendo
Dormir durmiendo
Mentir mintiendo
Etc.

'Seguir' by itself has different meanings such as: to follow, to chase, to continue, and many more.

When you use the verb 'seguir' + a gerund, it means that something continues to happen (something is still happening).

For example:

Sigo estudiando.

I am still studying.

Sigue enseñando.

He/She is still teaching.

¿Siguen hablando?

Do you guys are still talking (in touch)?

Sí, seguimos hablando.

Yes, we are still talking (we are still in touch).
